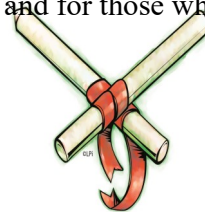
Thank you

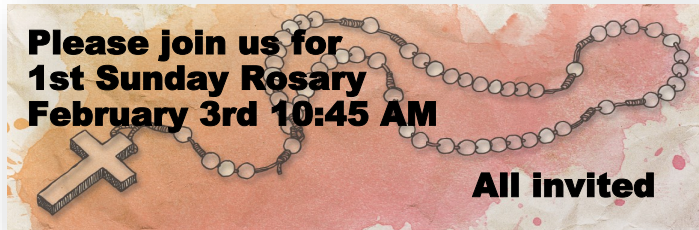
